## **PETE**

I love soldiers but I thought wouldn't it be cool to be one of the soldiers who marched all the way to Galveston Texas to deliver the good news to hundreds of enslaved people

### **JEAN**

So...your report is NOT about Halloween

**PETE** 

The report is, but the rap will be about Juneteenth.

**JEAN** 

Your report is about Halloween and your rap is about Juneteenth

PETE

Exactly

Every kid knows Halloween but not everybody knows Juneteenth so putting it in a rap makes sense right?

**JEAN** 

Yes it does....

**PETE** 

I just need to think of a rhyme

**JEAN** 

Maybe you break it in half? Rhyme *June* and then *Teenth* So moon----and uh....

PETE

Moon Thief?

**JEAN** 

**Juneteenth**
