

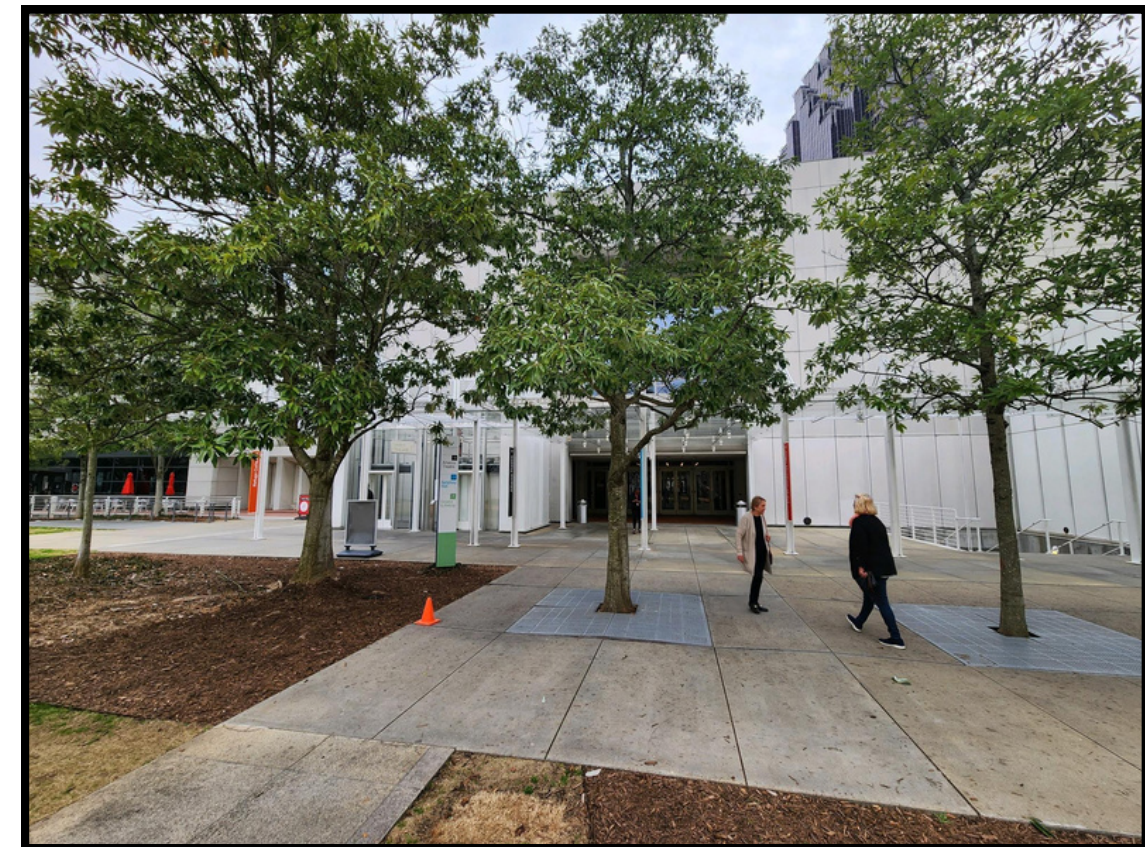

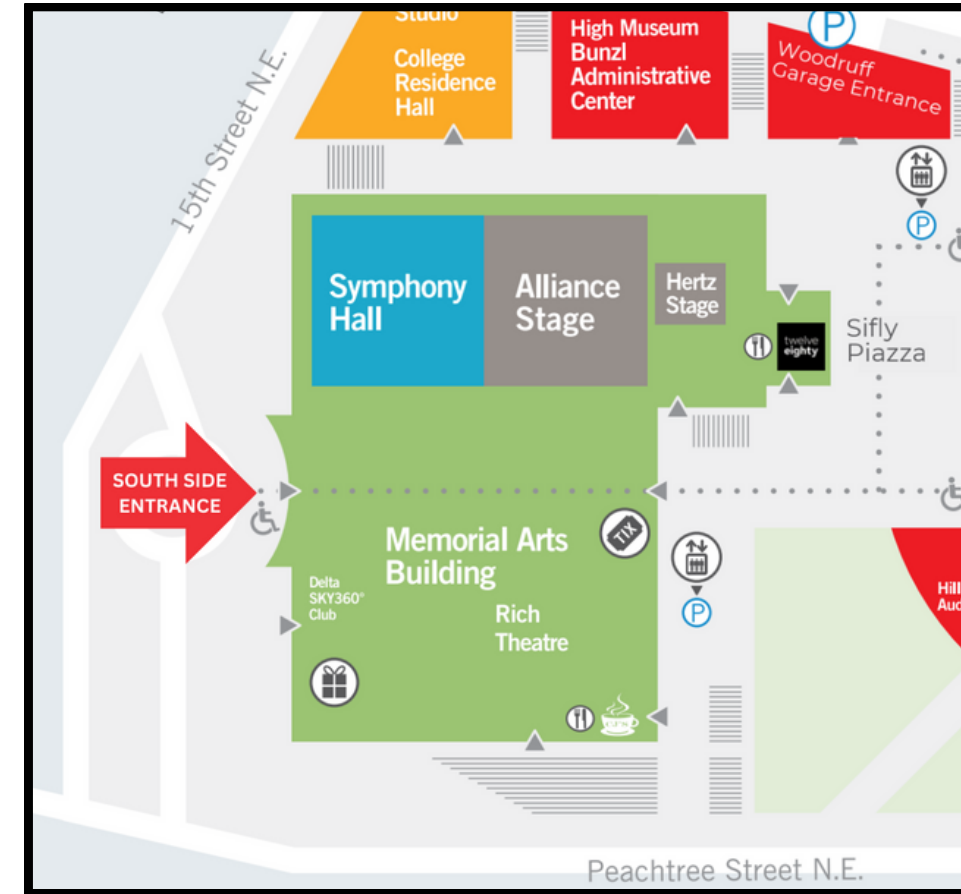


WEDNESDAY

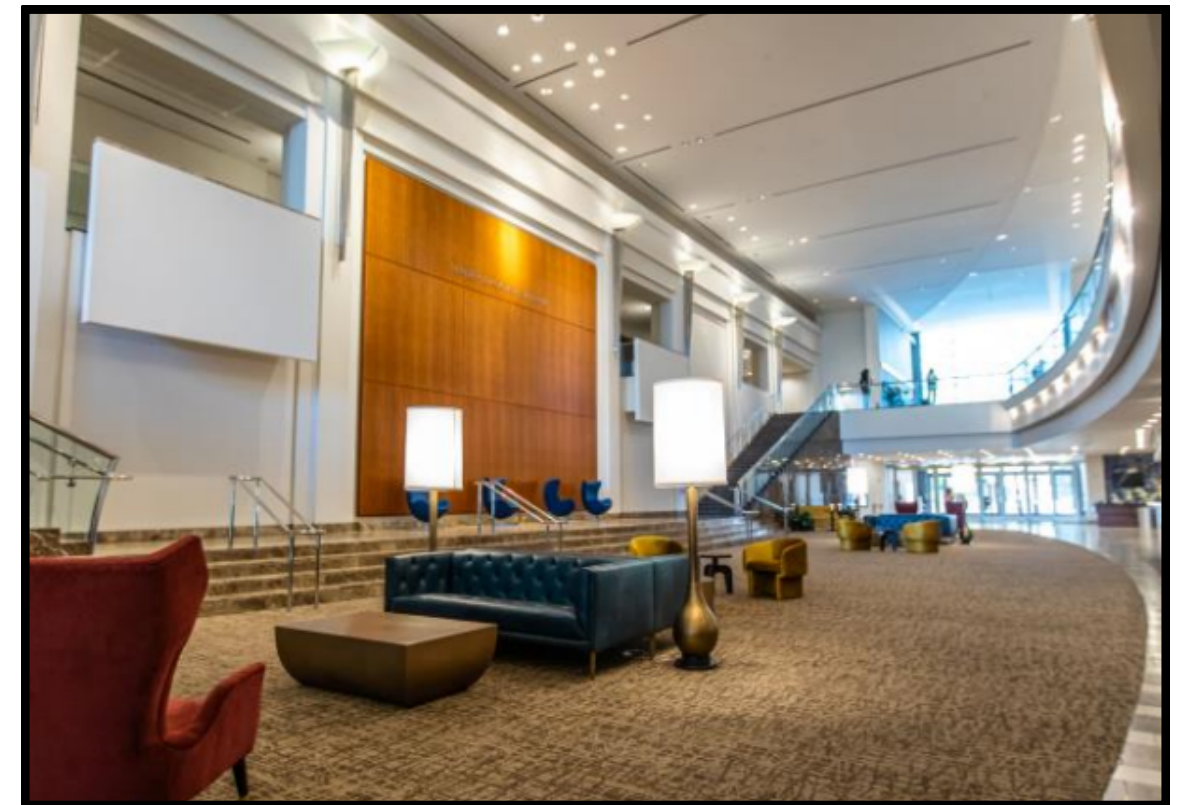
If I want to use a wheelchair accessible entrance, I will use the South Side Entrance, which is located at Peachtree ST NE and 15th ST NE.

available outside.

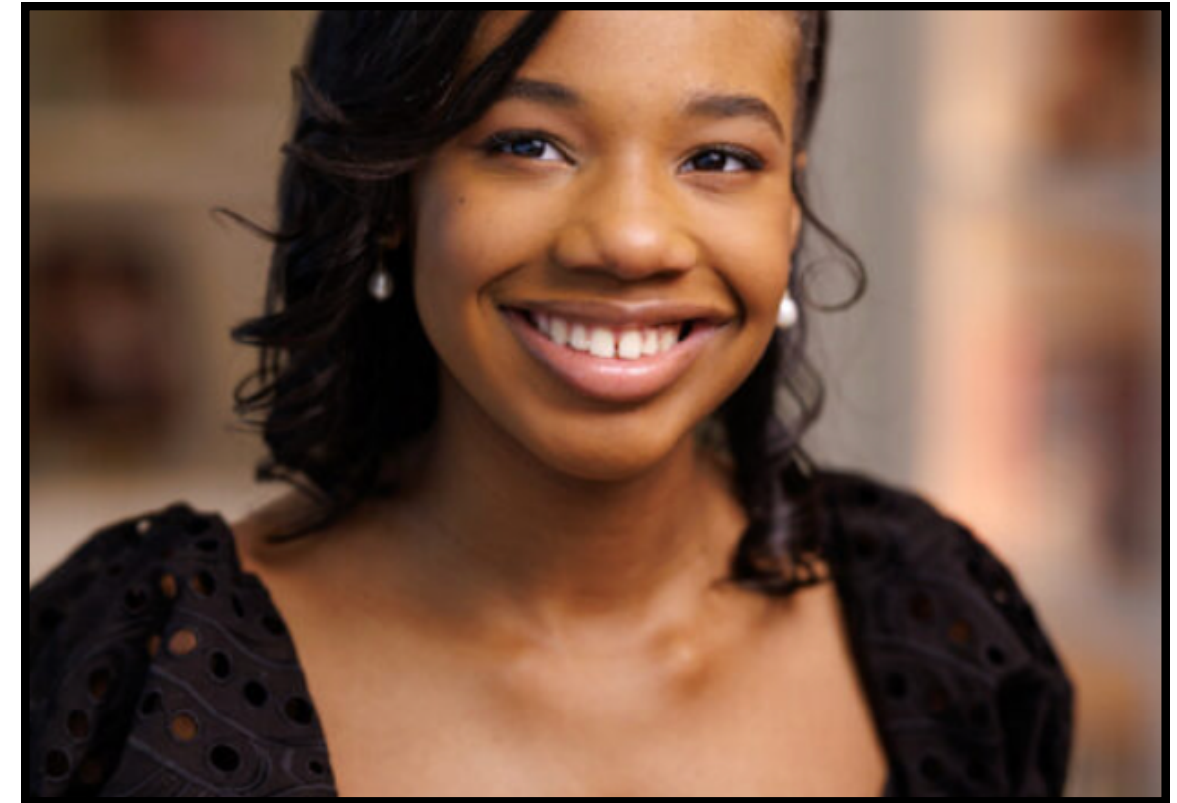


There will be a 15 minute break.

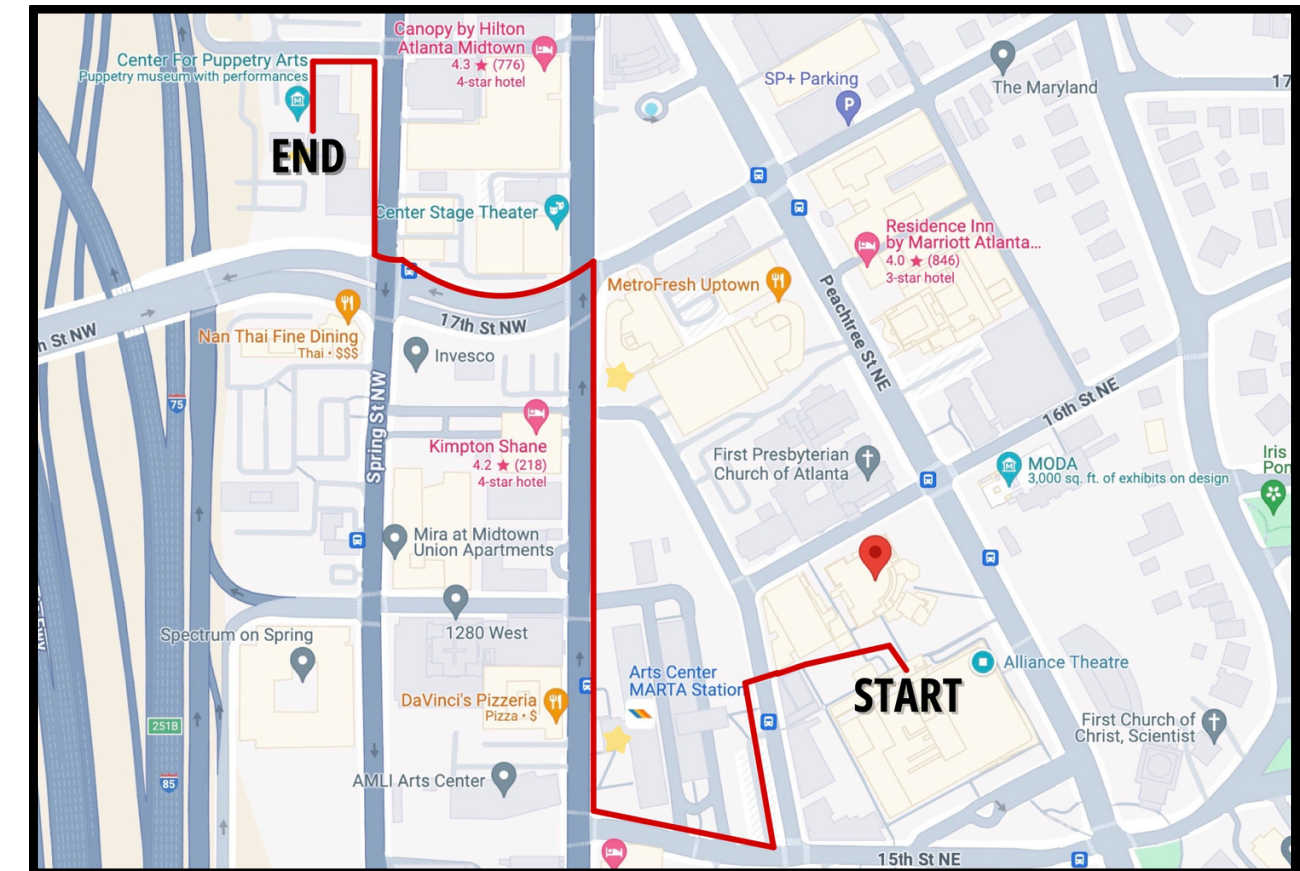
I will enter the Coca-Cola Stage and watch the Opening Ceremony.



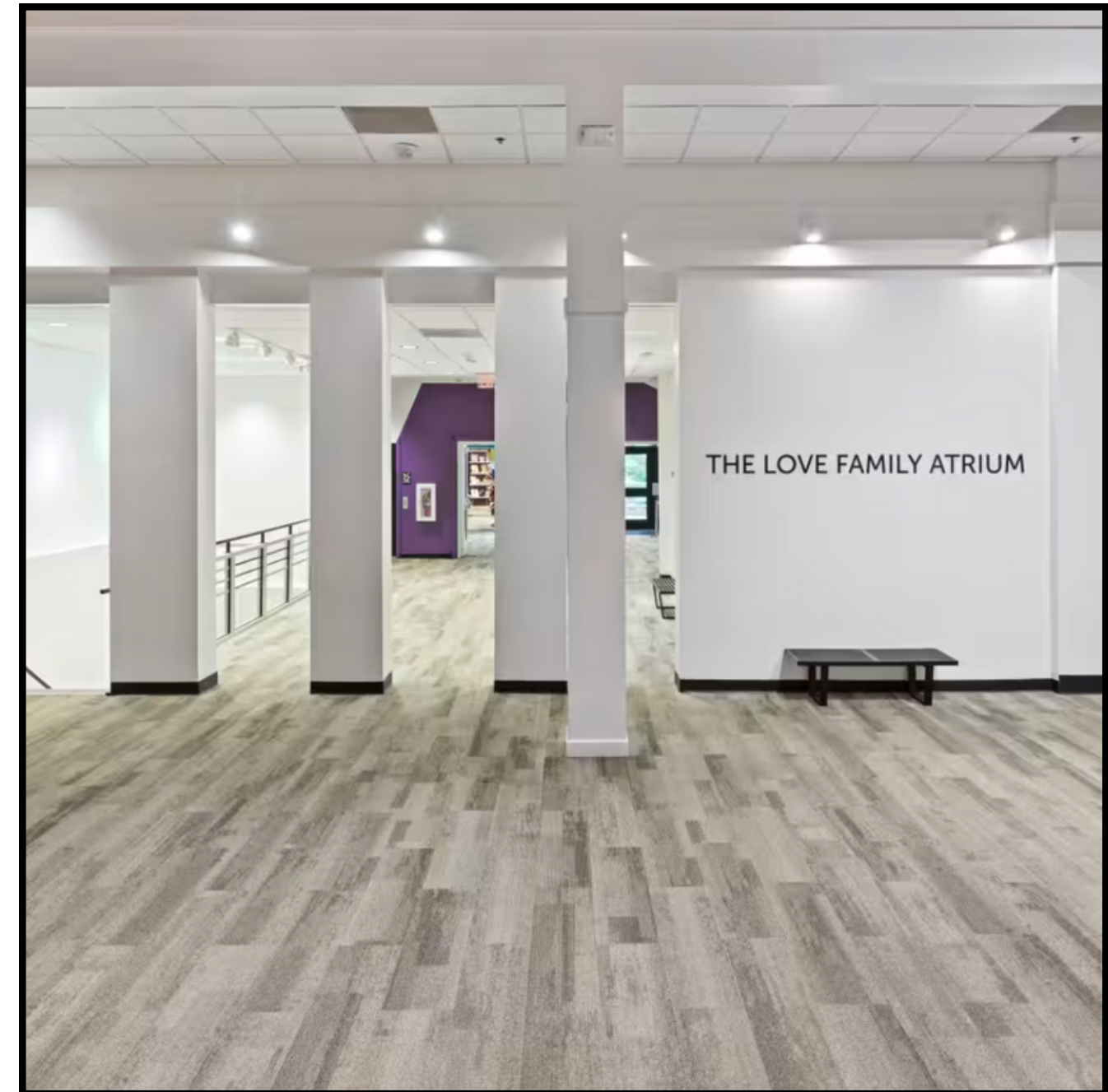
I will watch the Opening

Ground Collective.



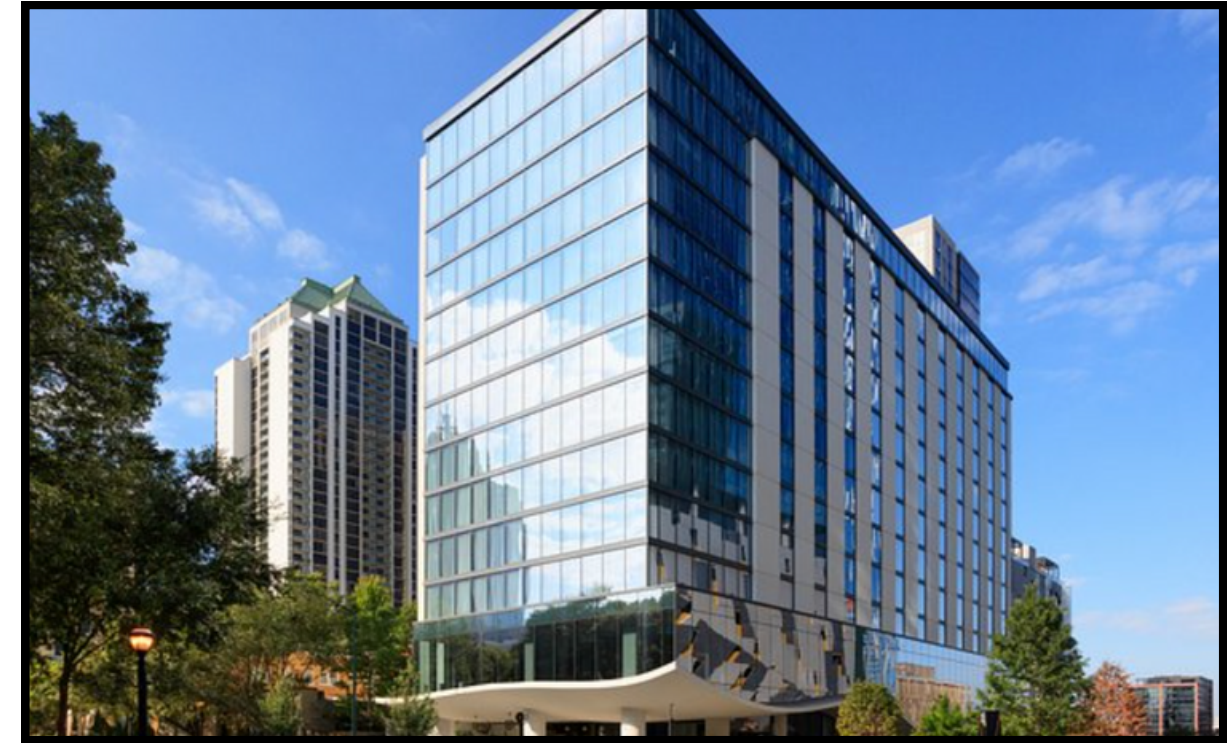
I will attend an opening reception where I can buy a drink from the cash bar and chat with other conference attendees.



For dinner, I can take a look at the list of restaurants using the QR code in the program to choose where to eat.



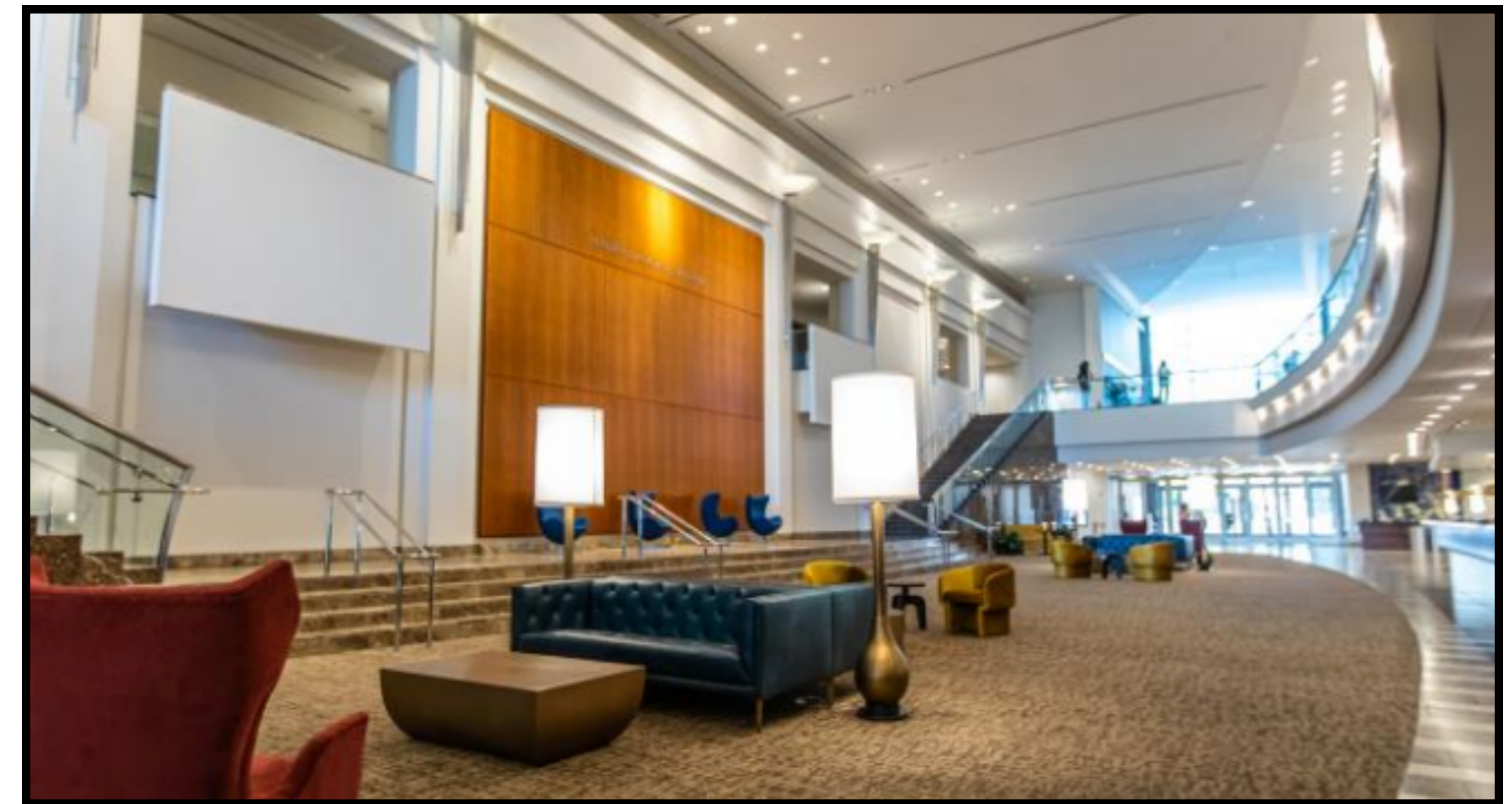
If I am attending the

There will be a 15 minute break.

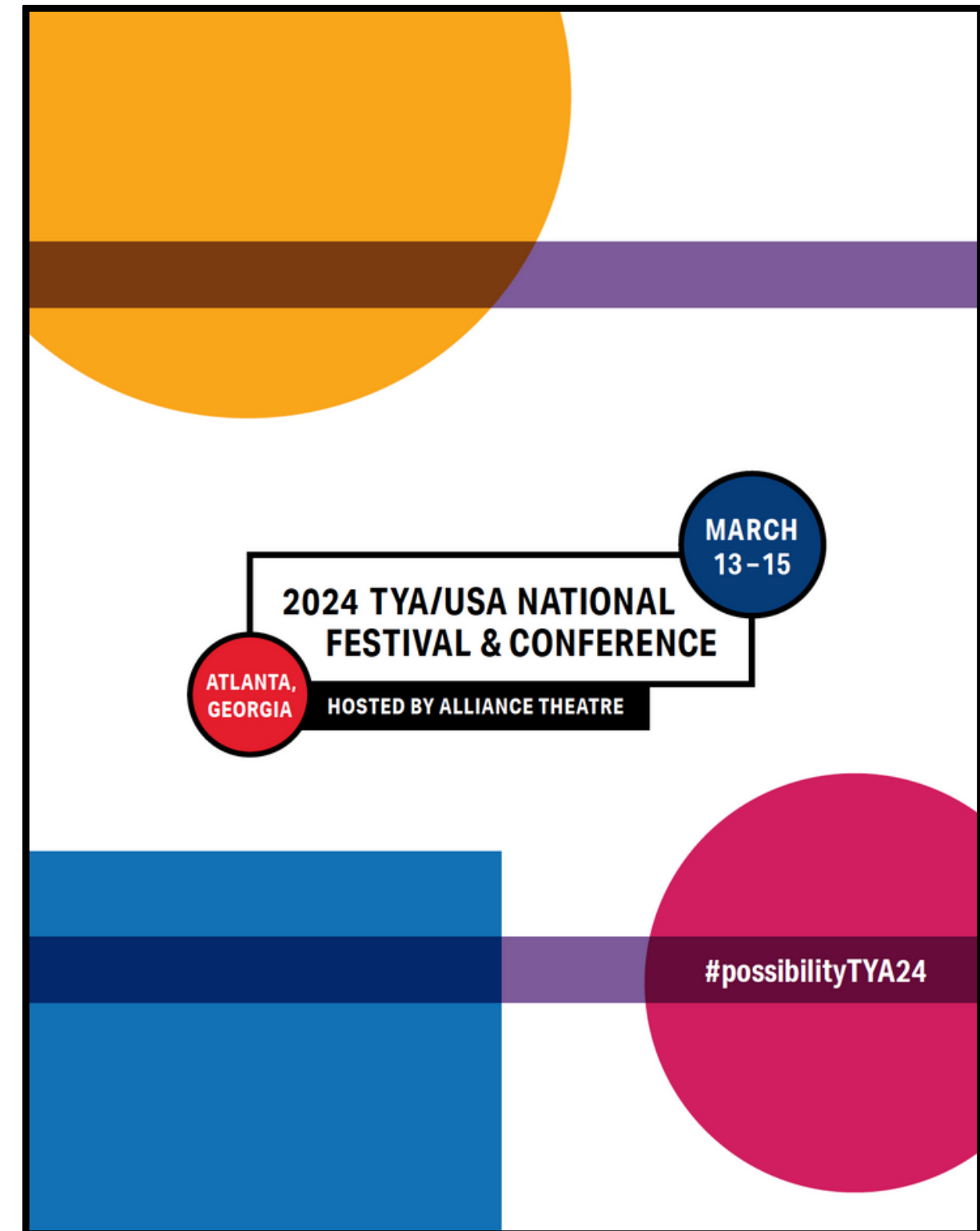
I will enter the Coca-Cola Stage

There will be a lunch break. I can take a look at the list of restaurants using the QR code in the program to choose where to eat.

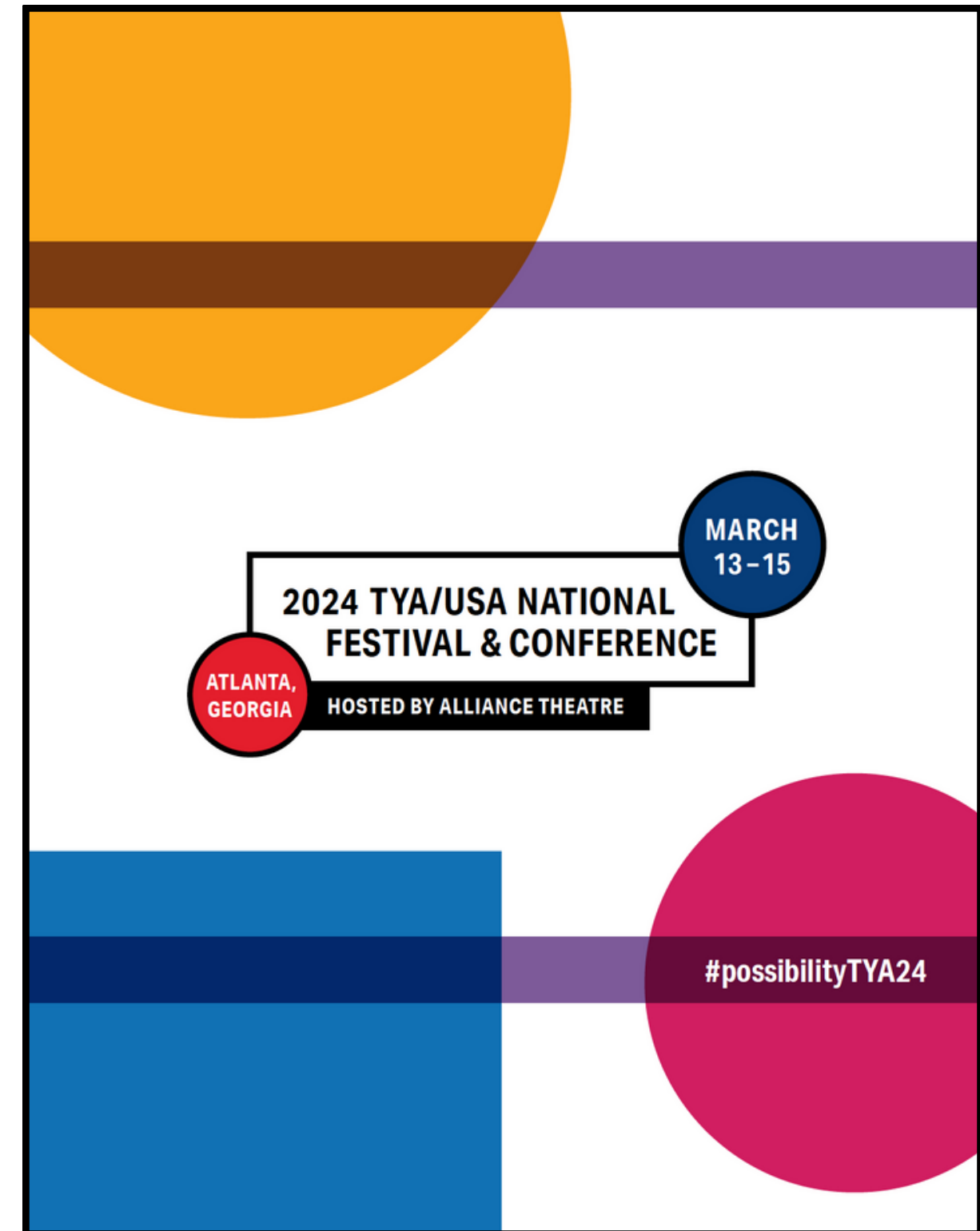


After the lunch break, I can choose from seven breakout sessions. I can use the map in the program to find my room location.

After the break, I can choose from seven breakout sessions. I can use the map in the program to find my room location.

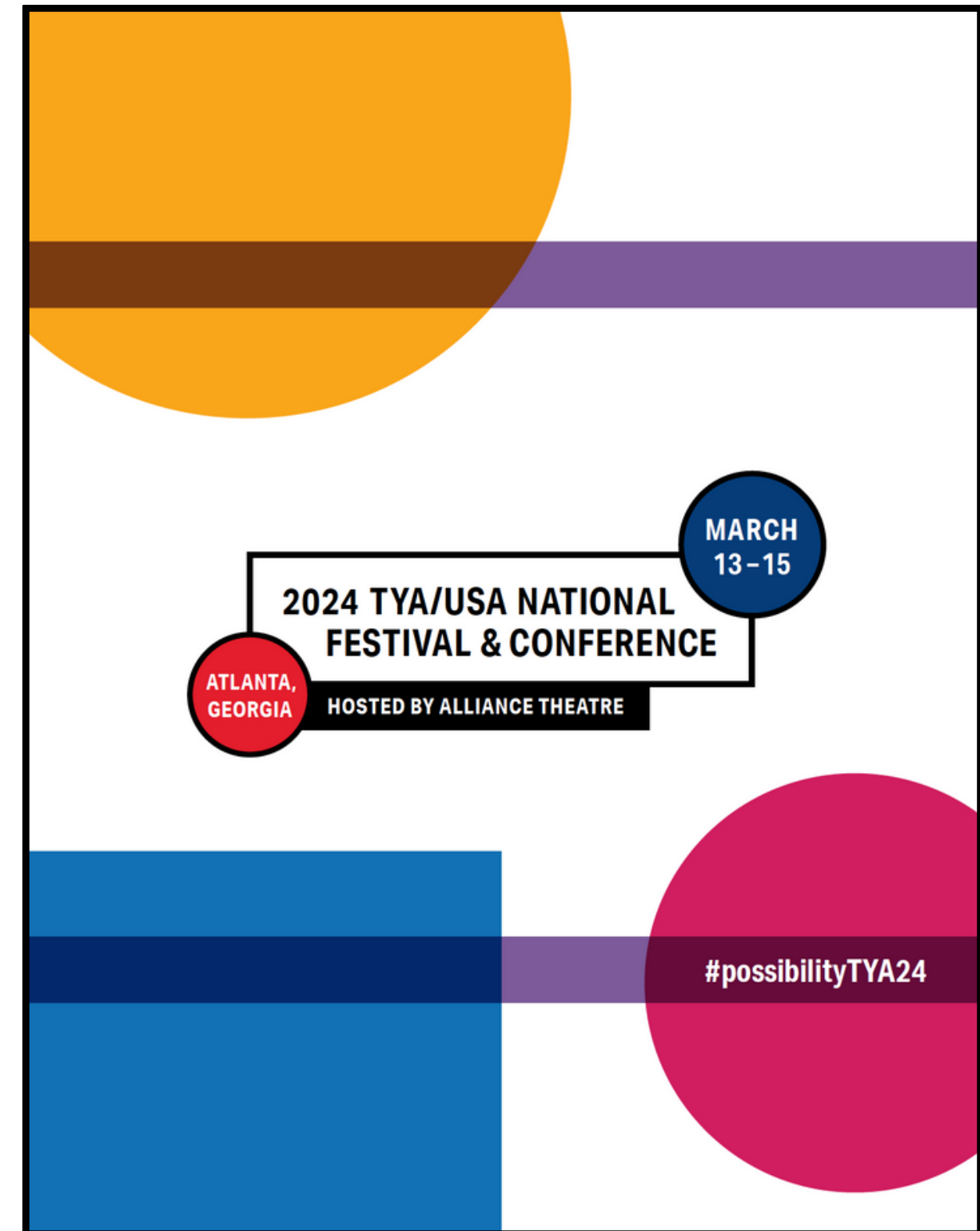


I can visit the vendor hall in the center space, where I can get a popsicle from the “King of Pops” stand.

meeting.

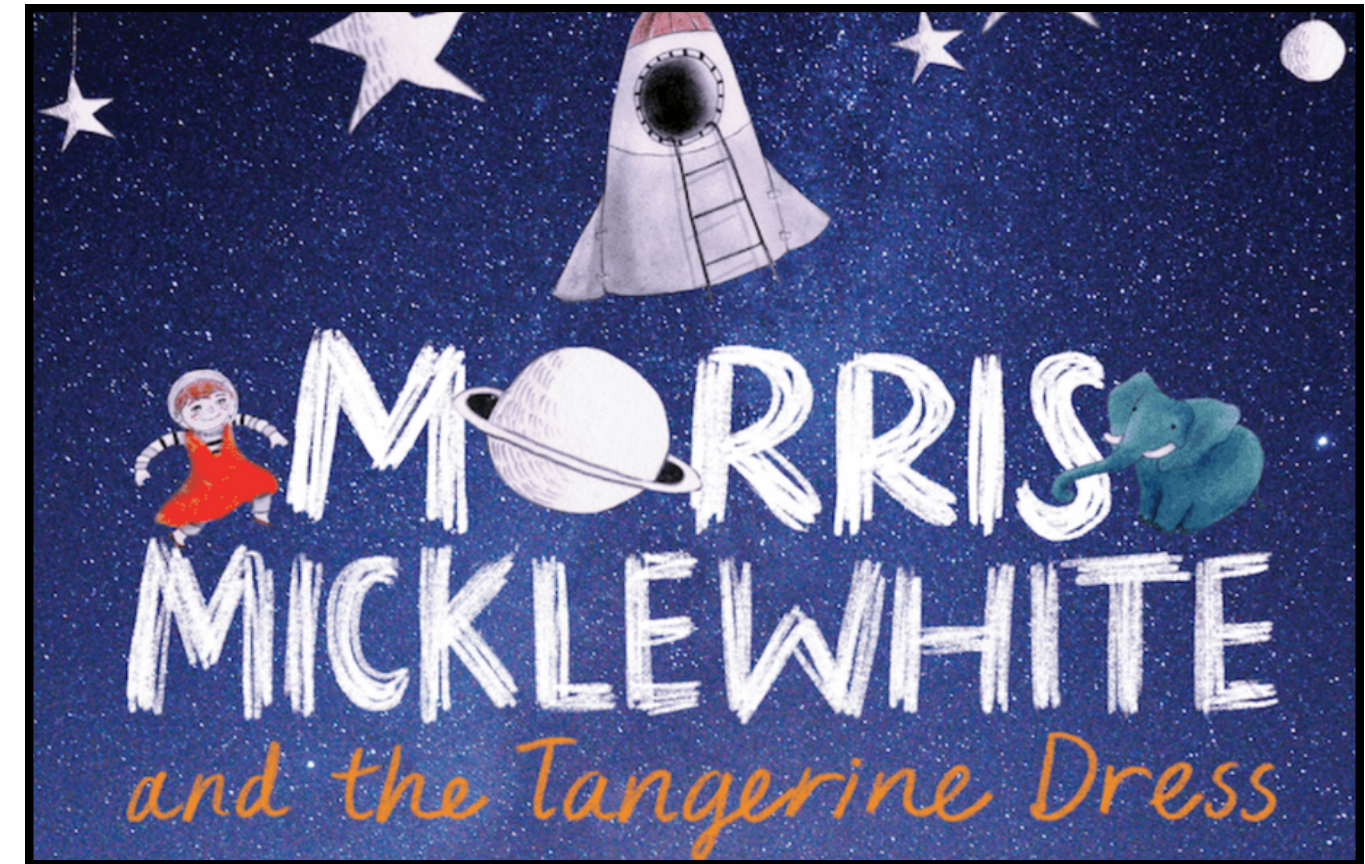

There will be a 15 minute break.

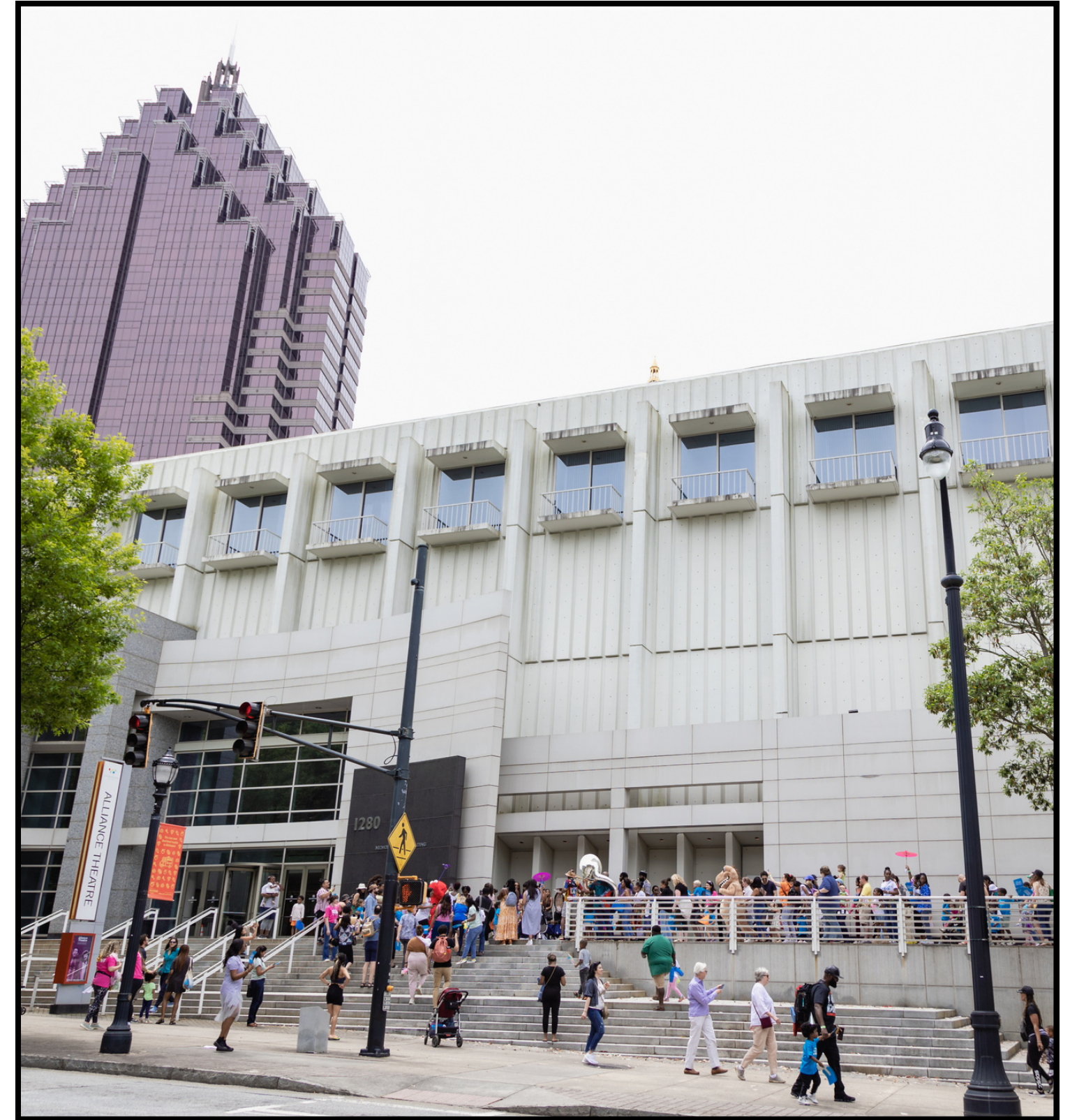
